Sheep: Es wird kein Hund zum Stellen verwendet. No set out dog is used

- Ducks: The handler before you sets out the ducks without dog. Last handler does it for the first run.
  - Runorder wird vor dem Trial ausgelost/ runorder will be drawn before trial Hündinnen in Hitze laufen in Startreihenfolge/ females in heat run in runorder

Die Anzahl der tatsächlich gelaufenen Läufe richtet sich nach den Meldungen für die einzelnen Tierklassen, die Anzahl der Läufe, die jedes Tier pro Tag laufen darf und nach der Anzahl Läufe, die die RichterIn, der Richter richten darf, sowie nach der Zeit, die dafür benötigt wird, aber nicht länger als 8 Stunden.

The number of runs that we will really do will be decided through the number of entries for the different classes of stock, the number of runs each animal is allowed to run, the number of runs the judge is allowed to judge and the time that is needed, but not longer than 8 hours.

AM Farmtrial May 23, 2024 Course Ducks #1

- 5 Enten pro run/ 5 ducks per run  
1- 28 runs möglich/ 1- 28 runs possible

Handler note: the focus is a calm and gentle stock handling.

5 ducks are set through pen 1 and gate 1, in the takepen The handler before you sets out the ducks without dog. Last handler does it for the first run.

### Penwork1 (5 points)

Open gate 1 and send the dog into takepen/ pen 2 to collect the ducks and take them out into the arena. Settle the ducks near the take pen on the left side of gate 1.

Advanced handler should stay outside the takepen to have the dog go in alone.

Open handler could go into the takepen with the dog.

### Sorting (25 points)

Sort 3 ducks into the Pen 3. Use gate 3.

Advanced : 3 marked ducks should be in the takepen. 2 unmarked remain in the arena.

Open: any 3 ducks, 2 remain in the arena.

After sort, let the 2 ducks join the 3 ducks in the pen. Close gate 3.

### Penwork 2 (5 points)

Take all ducks out of pen 3. Use gate 3.

### Penwork 3 (7 points)

Take the ducks from gate 3 into pen 4. Use gate 4. Close gate 4. Pen them out and keep them around pen 4.

### Gather (20 points)

Pole is set at 75 ft.

Open handlers can move 1/2 way before sending the dog. A stick will mark this 1/2 way position.

Advanced handlers must remain around the pole. Ends when the ducks are near the pole. Handlers may go some steps backward when ducks come to the pole.

**Location Specific Task 1 (20 points)**

Take the ducks over the bridge. Starts when ducks are at the pole and ends when ducks left the bridge.

**Location Specific Task 2 (20 points)**

Take the ducks between fence and the cone to the hold.

Advanced: Handler has to stay at the end of the bridge and may move when ducks are in the hold..

Open: Handler may move and assist.

Ends when ducks are in the hold.

**Chute (20 points)**

Take the ducks to the chute. Put them through.

Task ends when the ducks are through the chute.

Advanced handlers: the chute is closed at the end.

Open handlers: the chute is open at the end.

**Penwork 4 (8points)**

Take the 5 ducks to pen 3. Use gate 2. Take them through gate 4 to the alleyway.

Time ends when all ducks are in the alleyway and gate 4 and 2 are closed.

**All gates have to be closed.**

Time for ducks is 15 minutes with a 3 minute warning at 12 minutes.

Ties will be broken by:

- score on sort
- score on Specific Task 2
- score on gather

**Difference to trial 1: Chute is at another place**

- 5 Enten pro run/ 5 ducks per run
- 1- 28 runs möglich/ 1- 28 runs possible

Handler note: the focus is a calm and gentle stock handling.

5 ducks are set through pen 1 and gate 1, in the takepen. The handler before you sets out the ducks without dog. Last handler does it for the first run.

**Penwork1 (5 points)**

Open gate 1 and send the dog into takepen/ pen 2 to collect the ducks and take them out into the arena. Settle the ducks near the take pen on the left side of gate 1.

Advanced handler should stay outside the takepen to have the dog go in alone.

Open handler could go into the takepen with the dog.

**Sorting (25 points)**

Sort 3 ducks into the Pen 3. Use gate 3.

Advanced : 3 marked ducks should be in the takepen. 2 unmarked remain in the arena.

Open: any 3 ducks, 2 remain in the arena.

After sort, let the 2 ducks join the 3 ducks in the pen. Close gate 3.

**Penwork 2 (5 points)**

Take all ducks out of pen 3. Use gate 3.

**Penwork 3 (7 points)**

Take the ducks from gate 3 into pen 4. Use gate 4. Close gate 4. Pen them out and keep them around pen 4.

**Gather (20 points)**

Pole is set at 75 ft.

Open handlers can move 1/2 way before sending the dog. A stick will mark this 1/2 way position.

**All gates have to be closed.**

Time for ducks is 15 minutes with a 3 minute warning at 12 minutes.

Ties will be broken by:

- score on sort
- score on Specific Task 2

**Penwork 1 (4 points)**

Open gate of holding pen and pen 5 sheep out to the alleyway (pen1).

Advanced handlers preferred to have the dog go in alone without help.

Open handlers could go into the pen with the dog

**Penwork 2 (5 points)**

Bring 5 sheep to pen 2, use gate 1.

**Penwork 3 (8 points)**

Bring 5 sheep through gate 2 to the alleyway (pen 1), use gate 3 to pen 3, use gate 4.

**Sorting (25 points)**

Sort 3 sheep, 3 remain in pen 3, 2 in the arena. After sort, let the 3 sheep join the 2 in arena.

Use gate 5.

Advanced handlers have to sort 3 marked.

Open handlers have to sort 2 marked and one other.

**Gather (20 points)**

Settle sheep near gate 5.

Pole is set at 150 ft.

Advanced handlers must remain at the pole.

Open handlers can move 1/2 way before sending the dog.

**Location Specific Task 1 (20 points)**

Bring 5 sheep over the bridge .

**Chute (20 points)**

Bring 5 sheep through the chute.

Advanced handlers: the chute is closed at the end.

Open handlers: the chute is open at the end.

**Location Specific Task 2 (20 points)**

Bring 5 sheep into the hold. Note ear marks of any 3 sheep.

**Penwork 4 (8 points)**

Open gate of holding pen and pen 5 sheep out to the alleyway (pen1).

Advanced handlers preferred to have the dog go in alone without help.

Open handlers could go into the pen with the dog

**Penwork 2 (5 points)**

Bring 5 sheep to pen 2, use gate 1.

**Penwork 3 (8 points)**

Bring 5 sheep through gate 2 to the alleyway (pen 1), use gate 3 to pen 3, use gate 4.

**Sorting (25 points)**

Sort 3 sheep, 3 remain in pen 3, 2 in the arena. After sort, let the 3 sheep join the 2 in arena.

Use gate 5.

Advanced handlers have to sort 3 marked.

Open handlers have to sort 2 marked and one other.

**Gather (20 points)**

Settle sheep near gate 5.

Pole is set at 150 ft.

Advanced handlers must remain at the pole.

Open handlers can move 1/2 way before sending the dog.

**Chute (20 points)**

Bring 5 sheep through the chute.

Advanced handlers: the chute is closed at the end.

Open handlers: the chute is open at the end.

**Location Specific Task 1 (20 points)**

Bring 5 sheep over the bridge.

**Location Specific Task 2 (20 points)**

Bring 5 sheep into the hold. Note ear marks of any 3 sheep.

**Penwork 4 (8 points)**

Bring 5 sheep to pen 3, use gate 5, through gate 4 to the alleyway (pen 1) into the holding pen.

Time ends when all sheep are in the holding pen and all gates are closed.

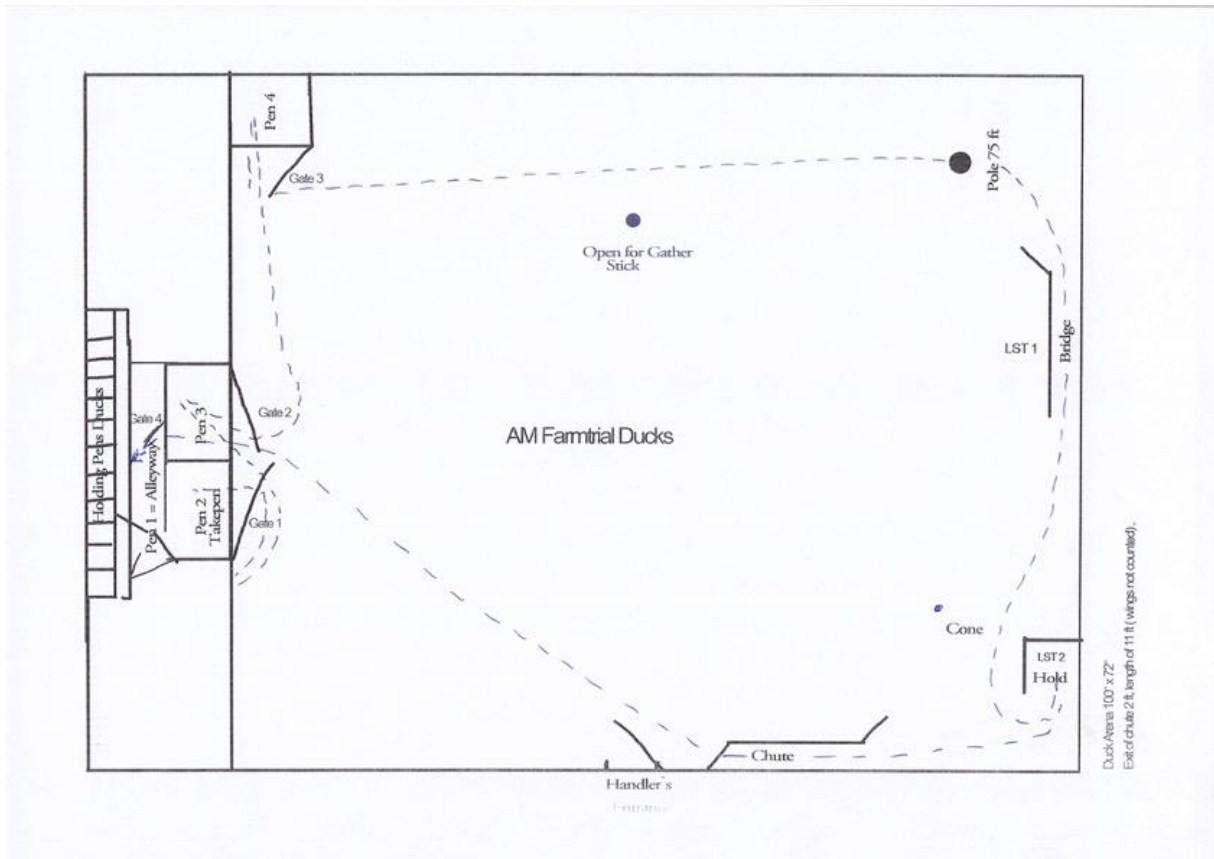

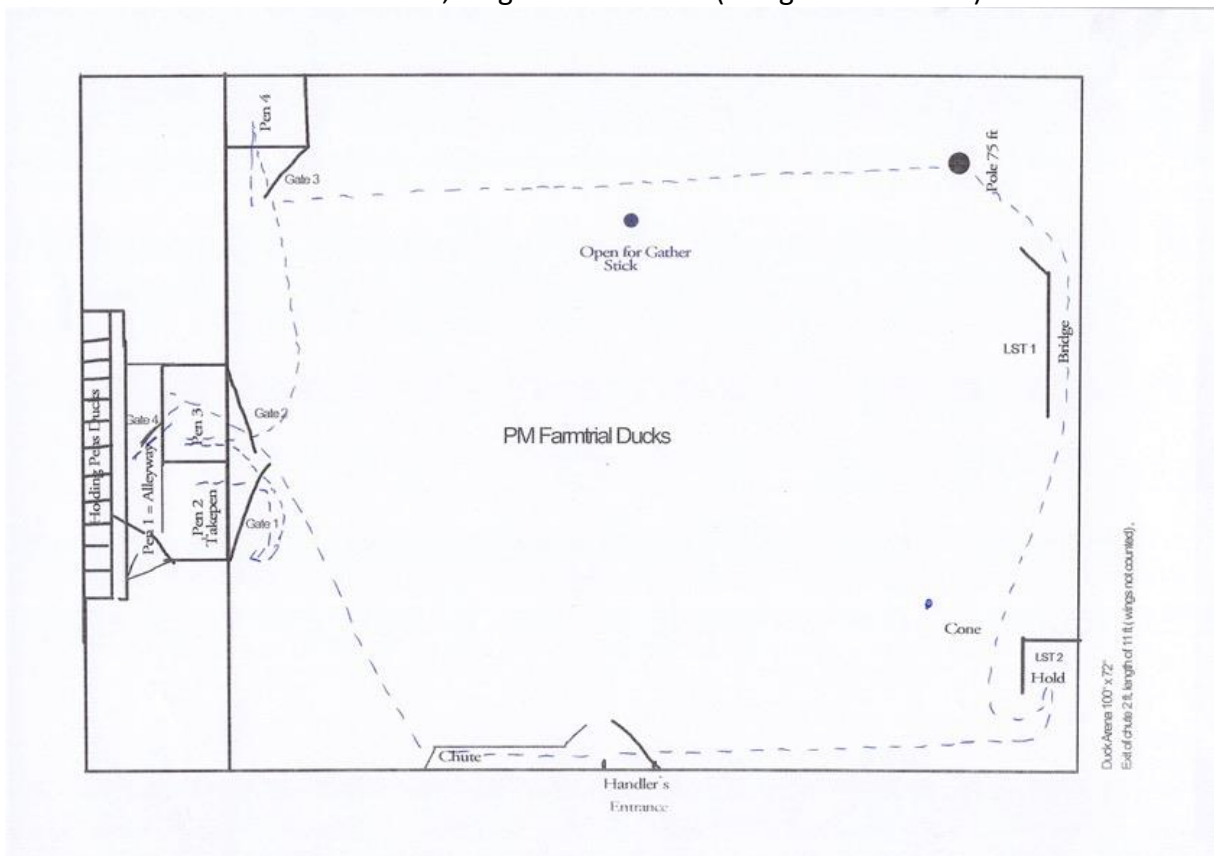

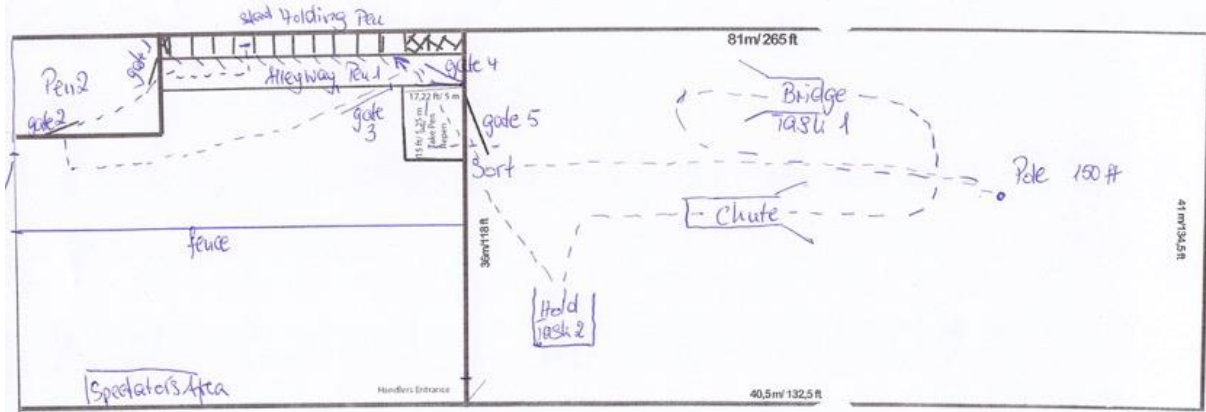
### **Diagram of the arenas (sheep & ducks)**
